
PREFERRED RACE COURSE FOR ALL BSC RACES:

Please note the preferred race courses which apply to all Club Races...Sunday Races, One Day Regattas, etc. and which can also be edited to apply to any Invitational Regattas which the Club might sponsor.

The PREFERRED course would be as posted as AX or ACAX, which have downwind finishes with the leeward mark(C) located to WINDWARD of the starting line.

NOTE to Race Committees: The leeward mark should be about 50-60 feet to windward of the line to allow room for the boats to round without coming too near the starting line or the RC boat.

This preferred course makes it much easier to adjust the course to suit varying wind directions, in that normally, only the starting pin would have to be moved to keep the line square to the wind, and then perhaps the windward mark, so that it is as near to directly upwind as possible. It also allows for a longer windward leg rather than a medium length first windward leg and a shorter second windward leg. This is particularly helpful when the wind is out of the East or West.
